## Which AMA Certificate Course is right for you?



### If you:

- Scored 15 you should consider the IAM Diploma course
- Scored 12 or more, then you should do the *Crash Certificate Course* or arrange for a clinic.
- Scored between 8 and 12 then you should:
  - top up your knowledge using the appropriate IAM Endorsed Training Scheme course from AMCL, or
  - do the do the *Compact Certificate Course*.
- Scored less than 8 then you should consider the *Comprehensive Certificate Course*.

Other considerations you might like to take into account include how quickly you wish to take the Certificate exam and how much flexibility you might want in training delivery.
